

TSCHANTRE, a conversion of a former industry plot into living spaces, both in Basel.
The approach to the projects is radical, the implementation is both pragmatic and poetic.
With texts by Melissa Freudiger and Harald Stühlinger. The melody between the
pages is progressive chic and the altogether is a unique and refreshing twentyfirst century book, including some never seen creative surprises.

People of all ages (and professions) have been gathered together in their natural habit in front of Albrecht's camera—the portraits give us that certain endless summer feeling in the mountains, but unkitschy and true: splendour in the grass!

In the early afternoon we take a short siesta at the room with a view (Tour Eiffel & Tour Montparnasse).




In the afternoon we have a meeting with Tsuyoshi Tane of ATTA. Book project? Book Project! (maybe)

Finally a nightcap at Ogata Bar with a large house made ice cube.


